



### Items Required for Registration

<b>Proof of Residency</b>	<p><b>Two (2) forms of Proof of Residency are required for every NEW and RETURNING student</b> <b>THE DISTRICT WILL NOT ACCEPT A POST OFFICE BOX NUMBER</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>First form</b> of "Proof of Residency" should be a <u>CURRENT UTILITY BILL</u> (gas, water, sewer, electric or land phone bill)</li> <li>2. <b>Second form</b> may be one of the following:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Occupancy permit with current date</li> <li>○ Current public aid card with current address in district</li> <li>○ Driver's license with current address in district</li> <li>○ Current voter's registration card with address in district</li> <li>○ Lease with last months rent receipt</li> <li>○ Additional utility bill such as phone, trash, etc</li> </ul> </li> </ol> <p><b>EXCEPTION TO THE TWO PROOFS OF RESIDENCY:</b> Private housing on Scott AFB. ONE form of proof will be accepted from those living in private housing on base. You will need to bring in a current <u>Minol</u> utility bill.</p>
<b>Certified Birth Certificate</b>	<p>Required for <b>all students new to district</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Original Birth Certificate Only.</b> Hospital Certificates will not be accepted.</li> <li>• NOTE: Students registering for Kindergarten must be 5 years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year.</li> </ul>
<b>Health Forms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Illinois Health Physical Form</b> Students new to Illinois must have a physical completed on a State of Illinois Health Physical Form. All <b>Pre-K, Kindergarten, 6th grade, and 9th grade students</b> must have a recent Physical. (Sports physicals must be done yearly.)</li> <li>• <b>Dental Exam Form</b> A dental examination form completed by the dentist, or waiver, if the student qualifies for one of four criteria, must be completed for students in grades <b>Kindergarten, 2nd grade, and 6th grade</b>. The completed form must be turned in to the school nurse by May 15th of that school year.</li> <li>• <b>Vision Exam Form</b> Vision exams will be required for all <b>Kindergarten students and any student new to the district</b>. (Illinois law requires that proof of an eye examination by an optometrist or physician who provides complete eye examinations be submitted to the school no later than October 15 of the year the child is first enrolled or as required by the school for other children. The examination must be completed within one year prior to October 15 of the year the child enters an Illinois school.)</li> <li>• <b>Immunizations Requirements - NEW for 2014-15 – see end of document</b> Students should be <b>up-to-date on immunizations</b> (bring shot record).</li> </ul>
<b>Transfer Forms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Release of Records Form</b> Parents of all new students will be required to complete this form</li> <li>• <b>Student Transfer Form</b> Required from the last school attended, if the student is coming from another Illinois school</li> </ul>



### Immunization Requirements for 2014-2015

Beginning this coming school year the State of Illinois will be requiring additional immunizations. Listed below are the required vaccines and the grades at which they will be required. Please check your child's shot record for their status. If you have questions please contact the school nurse or your healthcare provider.

**Mumps All students grades K-12** will be required to show proof of having had 2 doses of mumps vaccine. The first dose must have been received on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than four weeks (28 days) after the first dose.

**Rubella All students grades K-12** will be required to show proof of having had 2 doses of rubella vaccine. The first dose must have been received on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than four weeks (28 days) after the first dose.

**Varicella (Chickenpox)** Students entering **K, 6<sup>th</sup> grade, or 9<sup>th</sup> grade** will be required to show proof of having had 2 doses of varicella vaccine. The first dose must have been received on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than four weeks (28 days) after the first dose or proof of prior varicella disease or laboratory evidence of varicella immunity.

**Pneumococcal vaccine (PCV) ALL PRE-K** students will be required to show proof of having had the complete series of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV).
