

Immunization Requirements

Listed below are the required vaccines and the grades at which they will be required. Please check your child's shot record for their status. If you have questions, please contact the school nurse or your healthcare provider.

Mumps All students grades K-12 will be required to show proof of having had 2 doses of mumps vaccine. The first dose must have been received on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than four weeks (28 days) after the first dose.

Rubella All students grades K-12 will be required to show proof of having had 2 doses of rubella vaccine. The first dose must have been received on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than four weeks (28 days) after the first dose.

Varicella (Chickenpox) Students entering K, 6th grade, or 9th grade will be required to show proof of having had 2 doses of varicella vaccine. The first dose must have been received on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than four weeks (28 days) after the first dose or proof of prior varicella disease or laboratory evidence of varicella immunity.

Pneumococcal vaccine (PCV) ALL PRE-K students will be required to show proof of having had the complete series of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV).

All students entering 6th grade must show proof of having received one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV) or commonly known as the meningitis vaccine. All 12th grade students will be required to show proof of having received 2 doses of this vaccine, or one dose only if first one is received on or after the 16th birthday.

In addition to this new vaccination requirement, all entering 6th grade students will need to show proof of having received two doses of Mumps, Measles, Rubella and Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccines as well as a Tdap booster vaccine.
